

Downtown high-rise now has a name

Daniels Real Estate this week announced the new name of its downtown Seattle high-rise development: The Mark.

The name honors Seattle entrepreneurs who've make their mark on the world, said developer Kevin Daniels. The ZGF-designed building also will make its mark on the skyline. The facade has triangular planes set at different angles.

The 43-story project, formerly called Fifth + Columbia, is under construction and will have 528,000 square feet of office space on the upper floors and an SLS hotel on the lower levels. Also part of the project is the historic former sanctuary building, which will become a restaurant that James Beard Award-winner José Andrés will operate.

Daniels said The Mark is the only high-rise one in Seattle to have column-free office space. In addition, it will have the city's largest "living wall," with plants growing in a vertical plane.
